Directions: From Bend (Costco area). Take Hwy 20 East approximately 7 miles. Turn left on Dodds Rd. Just before mile marker 2 there will be a sign for Rhinestone Ranch. Turn right onto the gravel road/driveway marked Williamson Ranch Rd. Turn right just before the hay barn (first driveway on the right) and keep left at the island. Follow the driveway back past the cattle barn to the barns and park near the horse trailers. Staff will be waiting near the small four stall barn. Please please please drive slowly on the gravel road/driveway. There are lots of beloved animals and children, and we want to respect our neighbors with the traffic and the dust.

First day arrival: Once you arrive at camp, please check your child in with a staff member. If you have not already turned in your paperwork or payment, please do that at check in time. Help

your campers find a cubby to place their items. At this time you are welcome to notify staff you are leaving or you can stay for the Monday morning meeting with the campers.
