General Equine experience:

Beginner: Entry level rider. This rider has either never ridden, groomed or tacked up a horse, or is still learning how to groom and tack and is timid about riding a horse on their own, or doesn't have control of the horse on their own.

Level 2: This rider has been taking lessons and or ridden before. They know how to groom and tack on their own. They have control of the horse when riding but they are still working on their timing and how to use their aids effectively.

Level 3: This rider is a Level 2 rider but they have better timing and effectiveness when riding their horse.

Level 4: This rider is a Level 3 rider and is working on different skill sets for competition.

Level 5: This rider has been a Level 4 rider and has mastered skill sets and is competing in them.

**TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS**

These packages include two to three prescheduled weekly lessons on dates of lesson calendar provided.

Non refundable, non exchangeable. Fees Subject to Change.

Students involved in competitive team with lease horses or horses in training will be billed at the rate of either \$400/mo. and are allowed up to (3) lessons each week of the lesson calendar, or \$300/mo. and are allotted up to (2) lessons each week of the lesson calendar. These lessons will have set disciplines and prearranged patterns or lesson plans available ahead of time. It will be at the trainers discretion to change lesson plan if needed. The calendar year will take place from 9/1 to 9/1. If you wish to cancel your enrollment it will require 60 days written notice and you will be billed on a prorated amount from the date notice is received.

Trainer may require students to sign up for certain lesson times. If they are attending an upcoming show or event they must attend in order to participate in specific classes.

If trainer believes client needs one on one attention, they will have the option to switch their three lessons for the week to one private lesson depending on availability or pay at the rate of \$100/hr.

Please note: ALL payment options are for enrollment into the lesson program for the full calendar year (9/1 to 9/1) If you choose to stop taking lessons or miss lessons you are still responsible for your full payment plan. These lesson fees are nonrefundable. If you or your child is going to be absent from a lesson, you must contact Rhinestone Ranch 24 hours prior to your lesson time in order to move to a different lesson time for the same week (depending on availability which is not guaranteed) otherwise, they are non-transferable. There are no other make up opportunities available. Late payments made more than 10 days after the date of invoice is sent will be charged a \$5/day late fee. \_\_\_ INITIAL HERE

**CANCELLATIONS**
